Student Drop Off/Pick Up

Morning supervision begins at 8:35 a.m. Students are asked not to arrive before this time. Children are the responsibility of their parents or caregivers until 8:35 a.m.

Once classes are in progress, late students must enter the front doors and check in with the office. Parents are NOT to walk their child(ren) to their classrooms.

At the end of the school day, students who walk are free to leave. Students who are picked up meet their parents in the lower front yard if they are in JK/SK or Grade 1 and/or if they are a sibling of a student in JK/SK or Grade 1. Students from Grades 2-6 meet their parents at the Devonshire exit/entrance.

MORNING DROP-OFFS: For parents/guardians dropping off at the Devonshire entrance, the gate is locked at 8:50. If there is no staff member with a High Visibility vest waiting at the road, the gate will have been locked. If you are running late, PLEASE do not drop your child off at Devonshire but come around to the front of the school.!

END OF DAY PICK-UPS: PLEASE ensure to let your teachers (and the office) know if you plan to change your child's end of day routine. It is essential for student safety that we know from parents leither in writing (via e-mail or in alstudent's agenda) or by phone if your child's end of day routine will be different than normal.! Emergency Drills
