

IDENTIFICATION OF STUDENTS FOR SCHOOL-RELATED ACTIVITIES

It is the practice of the Near North District School Board and its schools to recognize, celebrate and promote our students' achievements and activities. The following background information sheet will provide parents, guardians and students with a list of ways a students' school-related information is displayed or published where annual consent is sought using the *Parent/Guardian Consent Form Identification of Students for School-related Activities*:

School activities may be reported in school and board newsletters, and on School and Board websites and on School and Board social media sites such as Facebook and Twitter. Individual students may be photographed or videotaped and identified.

The media, such as newspapers, television and radio, may be invited to the school for the purpose of reporting on newsworthy events or activities such as graduations, student achievements/awards, and current events. Their reports may include both non-identifying photos or videos of groups of students and identifying photos or videos of individual students.
