
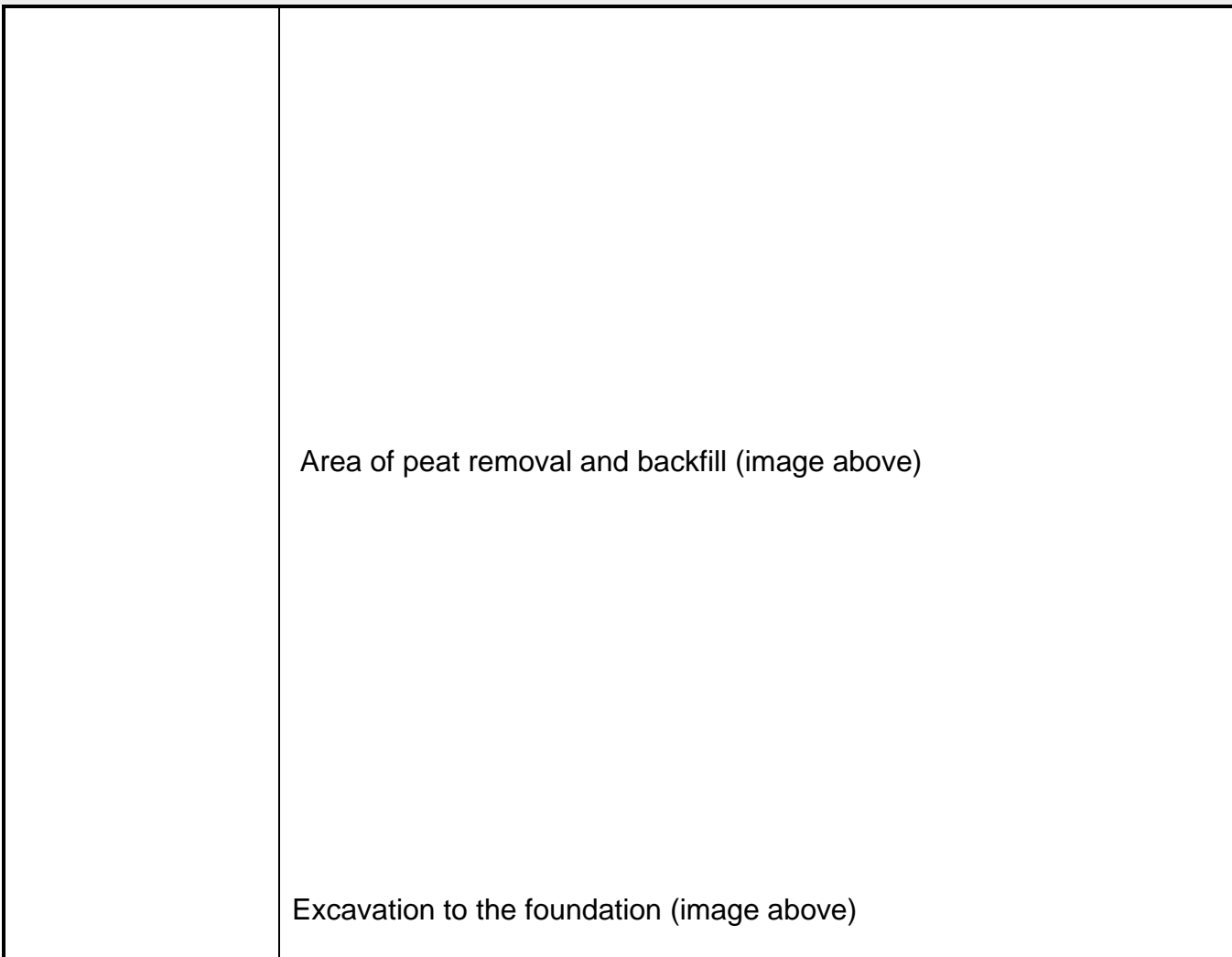
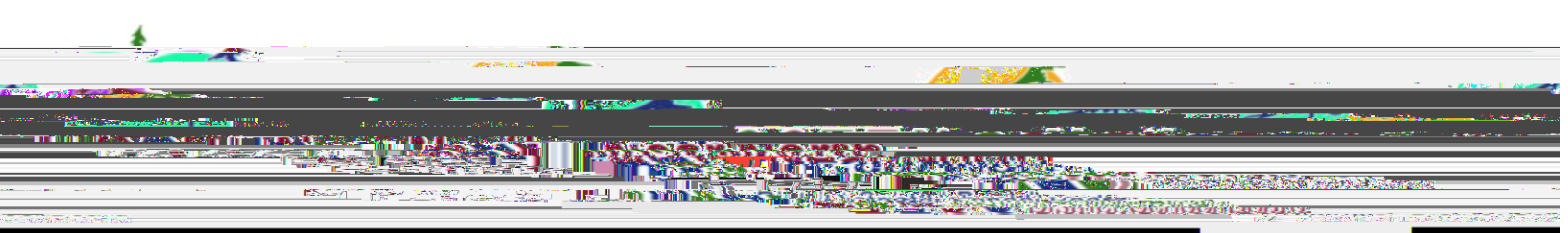


Title:	W.J. Fricker Project Update

Background:	<p>The Ministry of Education provided a funding allocation and approval to proceed, with additional funds provided by NNDSB, to build a new JK-6 school to replace the existing WJ Fricker Public School, 790 Norman Avenue, in North Bay. The new school is being built on the existing site, and is scheduled to open in September 2023.</p> <p>Venasse Building Group was awarded the construction contract and work began in October 2021.</p>
Update:	<p>The Fricker Build Committee is pleased to report the project is currently on schedule to reopen to students in September 2023. As well, the project is proceeding on budget.</p> <p>The committee heard from capital projects staff to note the project remains in the demolition stage.
